VARIETY: 65% Cinsault, 35% Grenache

APPELLATION: Mendocino County

DEGREES BRIX AT HARVEST: 26.5

VINIFICATION NOTES: The Cinsault fruit was chosen and handpicked specifically for the rose, harvested on October 4th. The grenache fruit was picked on October 6th and the saignée method was used. After a short amount contact time with the skins, the two varietals were fermented separately in 100% stainless steel tanks for 30 days.

A further four months of aging occurred before being bottled.

SENSORY NOTES: Vibrant aromatics and uplifting acidity combines with an expansive mouthfeel to create this dazzling rosé. Cinsault gives this wine stonefruit notes, while the grenache adds a touch of ripe grapefruit and citrus with hints of strawberry. This is a fresh, vibrant wine that will exude lovely fresh fruit in its youth.

VINEYARD NOTES: Fruit for this rosé was sourced from the incredible Alder Springs vineyard located in the far reaches of northern Mendocino County. Renowned grower Stu Bewley turned a former cattle ranch into one of the most well-known vineyards in Mendocino, growing world-class grapes. Rugged and remote, extreme slopes provide excellent drainage, while the unique composition of nutrients and minerals in the soil creates a unique microclimate influenced by its coastal location and elevation.
